the last named line in a Southeastly direction 336 feet, thence run in a South westerly direction from the last named line at right angle from the same 30 feet thence run Northward, at an angle of 44 degrees west by North and at right angle from the last named line 696 feet place of beginning of Block 5.

Block A has twelve lots in it each is 130 feet long and 25 feet wide.  
 Block B has 5 lots in it each lot is 130 feet long and 25 feet wide except lot 2 which is 15 feet wide at the North end and lot one which is 63 1/2 feet wide at the south end and is 100 feet long and runs to a point at the north and as shown by the annexed map.  
 Block C has three lots in it all 130 feet long. lot one is 50 feet wide, lot 2 is 48 1/2 feet wide, lot 3 is 60 feet wide.  
 Block D has three lots in it each 130 feet long. lot one is 47 feet wide, lot 2 is 63 feet wide, lot 3 is 60 feet wide.  
 Blocks E and F have each 16 lots in them all 130 feet long and 25 feet wide except

Block 1 in Block 5 which is  $4\frac{2}{3}$  feet wide, and lot one in Block 2 which is  $4\frac{2}{3}$  feet wide.  
 Block 1 is one lot shaped thus  $\Delta$  and is  $32\frac{2}{3}$  feet wide at the South and 57 feet long on the East side and 66 feet long on the west side.  
 Block one has 24 lots in it all 25 feet wide and 140 feet long except lot 22 which is cut off in length at one corner as shown by the attached map. Lot 23 which is 50 feet wide and 90 feet long, and lot 24 which is 100 feet wide and 80 feet long at the South side, and  $32\frac{2}{3}$  feet long at the North side."

Block 2 has 28 lots in it each lot is 25 feet wide and 120 feet long.

Block 3 has 28 lots in it which are each lot 25 feet wide and 140 feet long.

Block 4 has 26 lots in it each lot is 25 feet wide and 130 feet long except lot 26 which is 36 feet wide.

Block Five has 13 lots in it, each lot is 25 feet wide and 130 feet long.

Block 6 has 28 lots in it, each lot is 25 feet wide and 140 feet long.

Block 7 has 28 lots in it each lot is 25 feet wide and 120 feet long.

Block 8 has 28 lots in it each lot is 25 feet wide and 140 feet long.

Block 9 has 13 lots in it, each lot is 25 feet wide and 140 feet long, except lot 1 which is  $10\frac{1}{2}$  feet wide and 47 feet long at the south side and runs to a point at the north end, and lot 2 which is 112 feet long at the south side and 47 feet long at the north side, and lot 12 which is 50 feet wide and  $134\frac{1}{2}$  feet long at the south side, and lot 13 which is 75 feet wide and 67 feet long at the North end. All shaped as shown by the attached map.

All streets and Avenues are 60 feet wide except First street which is 25 feet wide and head street which is  $6\frac{1}{2}$  feet wide, and Main street which is 80 feet wide.

All alleys are 20 feet wide except the alley across Blocks Two and seven which is 10 feet wide.

All streets and alleys and Avenues are hereby dedicated to the public as highway for traveling on.
