

General Description

The Townsite of Bisbee, Towner County, Dakota Territory is situated in the South Half of the North Half of the North West Quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ of N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section numbered One (1) Township numbered One Hundred and Fifty nine (59) North of Range numbered Sixty eight (68) West of the Fifth (5) Principal Meridian and is now definitely described by the following survey and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the Western Boundary line of said Section One (1) a distance of Six Hundred Sixty four and Fifty seven one hundredths (664.57) feet South of the North West corner thence running South along the West boundary line of said Section One (1) Six Hundred Sixty four and Fifty seven one hundredths (664.57) feet thence East at an angle of Eighty nine degrees, Fifty seven minutes and Thirty seconds (89° 57' 30") to last course, Two Thousand Six Hundred Forty seven and Forty five one hundredths (2647.45) feet, thence North at an angle of Eighty nine degrees and Fifty seven (89° 57') to last course Six Hundred Sixty three and Nineteen One Hundredths (663.19) feet, thence West at an angle of Ninety degrees and Three minutes (90° 3') to last course Two Thousand Six Hundred Forty six and Fifty one one hundredths (2646.51) feet to place of beginning.

The above described tract of land has been duly surveyed and laid out into lots, Blocks, Streets and Alleys as shown by and upon the adjacent plat thereof. All distances and dimensions on the aforesaid plat are given in figures indicating feet and decimal parts thereof. All streets are Eighty feet wide, except Labell Street which is Forty (40) feet wide. All alleys are Twenty feet wide.

All Lots are as indicated upon the aforesaid plat.

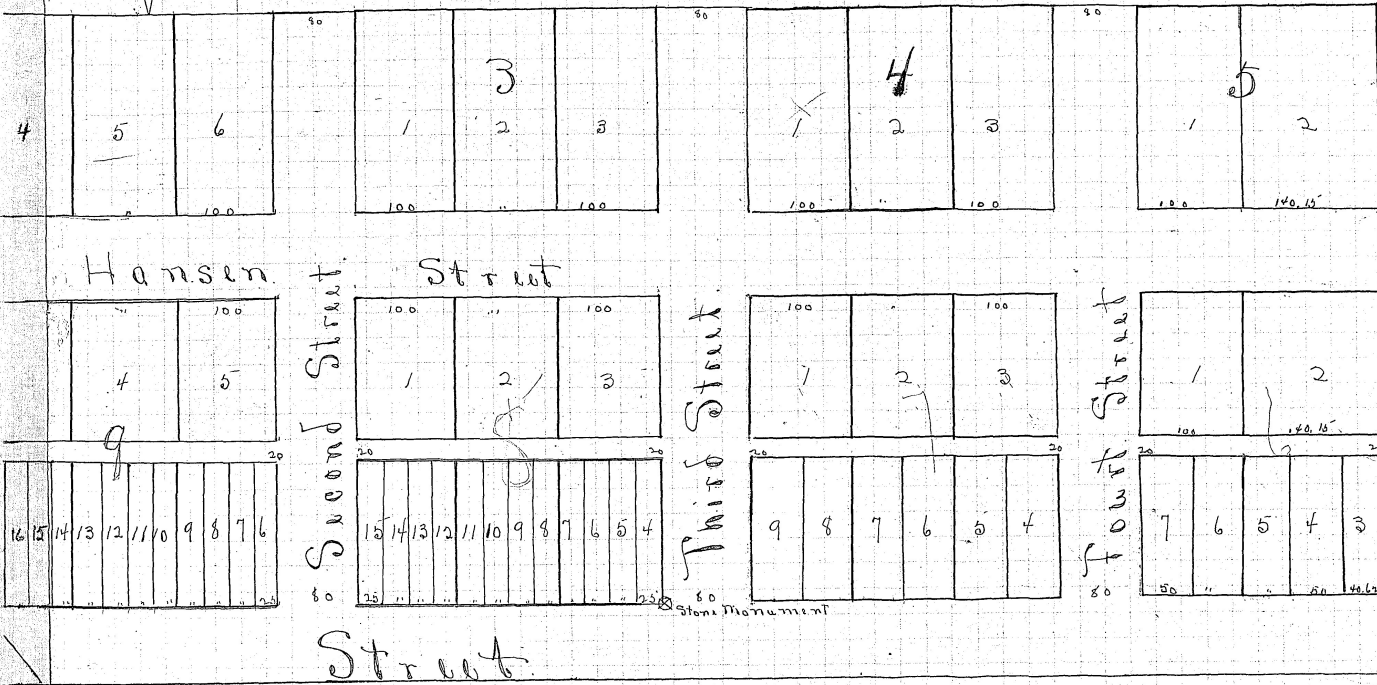
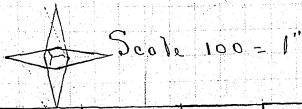
Stone Monuments.
