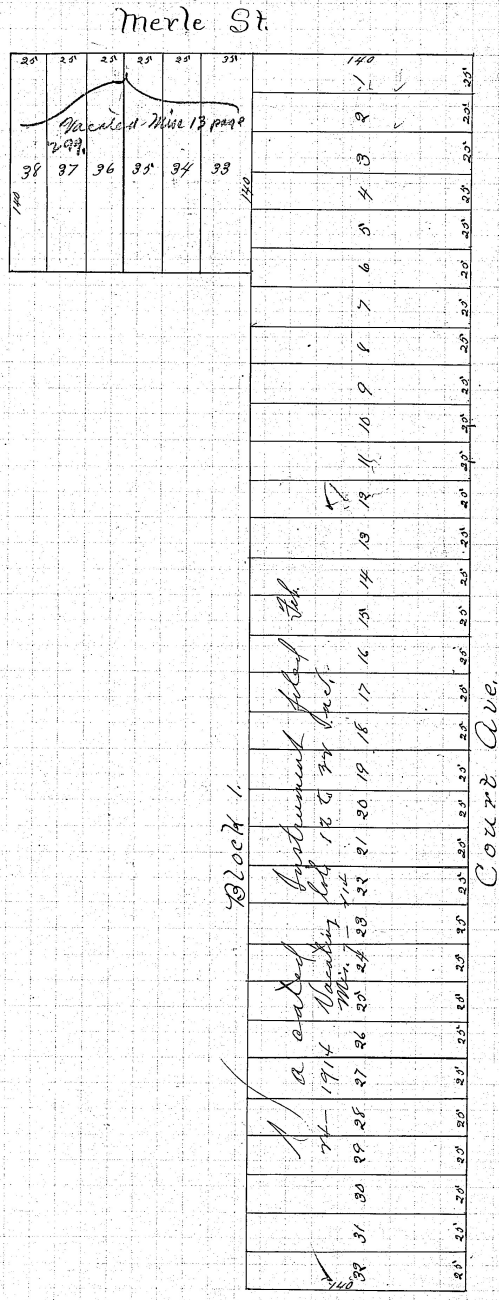

Lords Addition to Cando.



I, Lester Thompson, County Surveyor for Towner County, North Dakota, do hereby certify, that I have made an accurate survey of the plat of ground in the Northwest corner of $\frac{1}{4}$ in the Northwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 29, Tp 158 - R 66; said plat to be known as Lords Addition to Cando, in Towner County. All lots were measured and platted as shown by the accompanying map, using stakes set by the surveyor in Putnam's Addition to Cando, as a base line, viz. Stake at S.E. corner of Lot 24 and the south line of Block D in Putnam's Addition to Cando.

Block 1, consists of 38 lots, 37 of which are each 25 feet by 140 feet and 1 lot 30 feet by 140 feet viz. Lot 33. Signed this 23rd day of June 1905.
