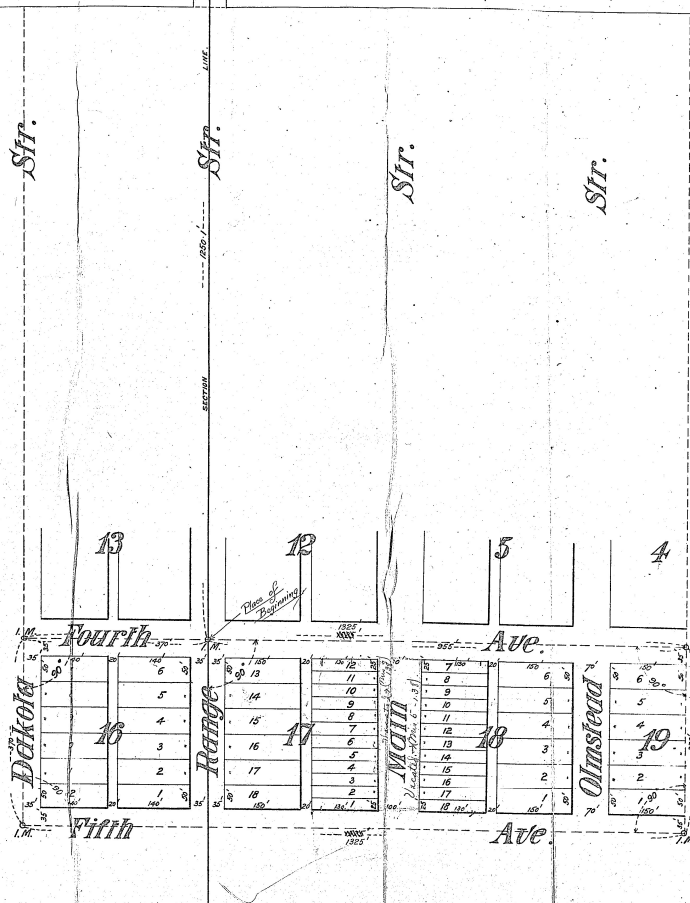


Plat of

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that, The Minnesota Loan and Trust Company a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota, the owner and proprietor of that certain land situated in the County of Towner and State of North Dakota and being all that portion of the West Half of the North West Quarter (W 1/2 of N. W. 1/4) of Section Six (6) in Township One Hundred and Fifty-Nine (159) North of Range Sixty-Five (65) West and the East Half of the North East Quarter (E 1/2 of N E 1/4) of Section One (1) in Township One Hundred and Fifty-Nine (159) North of Range Sixty-Six (66) West described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at an iron monument located on the West Line of Said Section 6 at a point 1250.1 feet South of the Section Corner, thence to the left at right angles a distance of 955 feet to an iron monument thence to the right at right angles a distance of 370 feet to an iron monument, thence to the right at right angles a distance of 1325 feet to an iron monument, thence to the right at right angles a distance of 370 feet to an iron monument, and thence to the right at right angles a distance of 370 feet to the place of beginning.

Has caused the same to be surveyed, platted and hereafter known as Blocks 16, 17, 18 and 19 in the Town of EGELAND and hereby donates and dedicates to public use forever all the Street avenues and alleys thereby shown.
