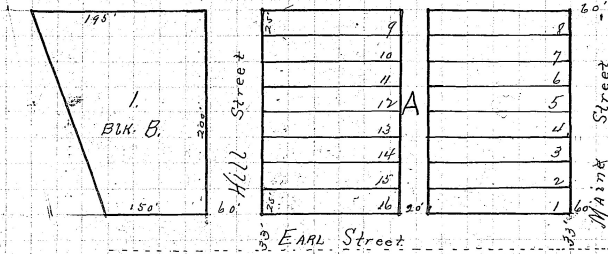


McDonalds Fifth Addition To Cando.



MCDONALD'S FIFTH ADDITION TO CANDO.

I, Lester Thompson, County Surveyor, Do Hereby Certify, that McDonald's Fifth Addition to the Townsite of Cando, Towner County, North Dakota, is situated in the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Sec. 20th Twp. 158, R.66, described as follows: Beginning at a point 33 feet north of the North East corner of Block B in McDonald's Third Addition to Cando, thence north 200 feet, thence west 555 feet, thence in a southeasterly direction to a point 200 feet south, parallel with the Great Northern Railway's Right of Way, thence east 510 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2.4 acres, Lots, Streets and Alleys have been laid out according to dimensions as shown on accompanying plat.
