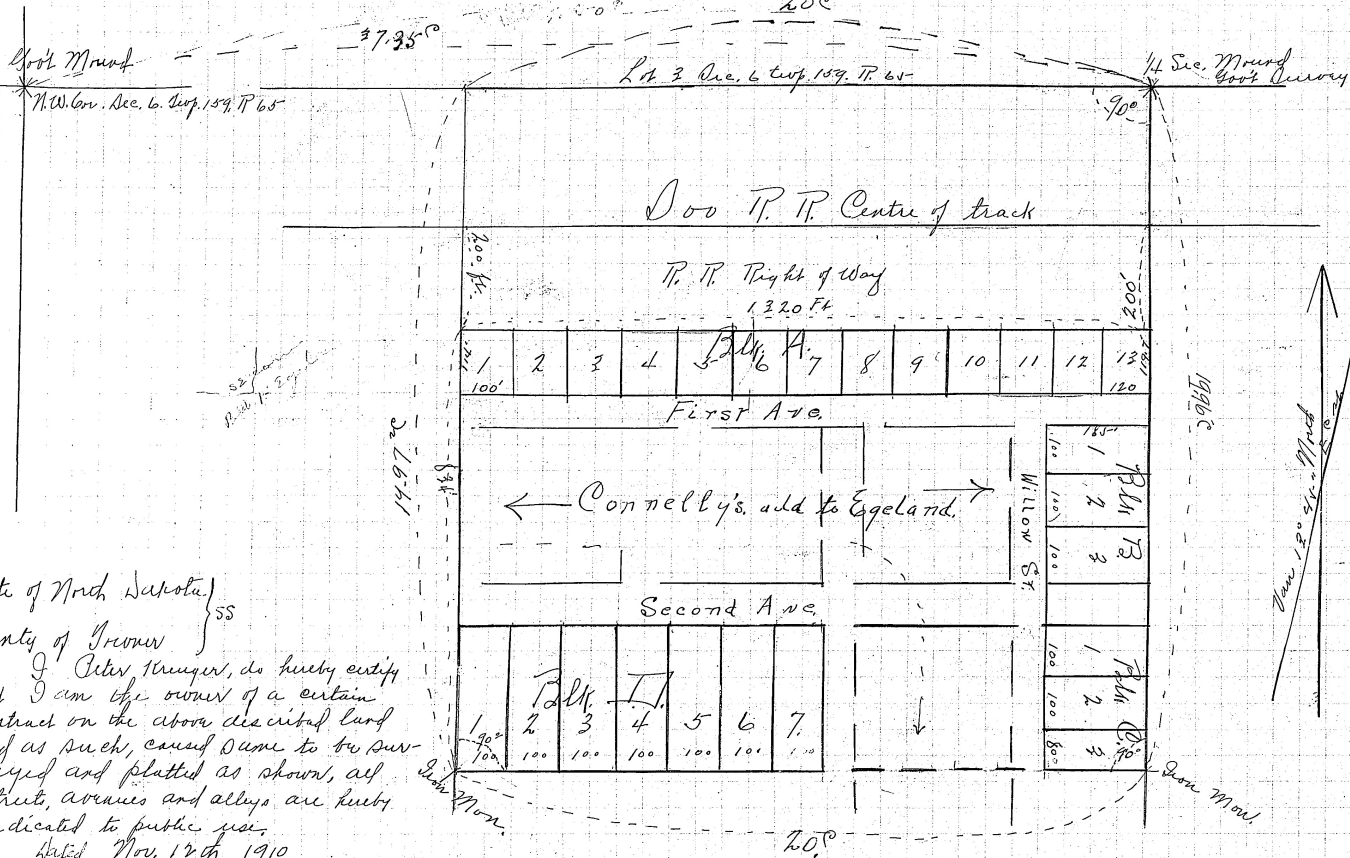


PLAT OF *Thruway* Addition to Egeland

 I, Peter Thruway, do hereby certify that I am the owner of a certain tract of land as shown on the above described plat and as such, caused same to be surveyed and platted as shown, all streets, avenues and alleys are hereby dedicated to public use.

 on this 12th day of November 1910, before me personally appeared Peter Thruway and acknowledged to me that he executed the above instrument and known to me that he executed the same.
 I, Elmer J. Judd, County Surveyor for Towner County, State of North Dakota, Registrar of Deeds, do hereby certify that I have made a survey of a certain tract of land to be known as *Thruway's* addition to Village of Egeland. Said tract of land comprising all of that portion Lot 3, Dec. 6 in Supp. 159 T.P. 65 - not included in tract belonging to the Do. T.P. Co. and Plats 1-2-3-4 in what is platted as Connelly's addition to Egeland, survey commencing at the 1/4 Sec. bound of the original Government Survey of said land and following lines and courses as shown by accompanying map. Said tract of land containing 11.04 acres more or less according to survey thereof. Plat B is a strip of land divided into 3 lots as shown, lots 1 to 12 being 100' wide and lot 13 being 120' wide, and all lots extending North from North Bound of 1st Ave. Connelly's addition to the Right-of-way of Do T.P. Co. Plat B has 3 lots each 100' x 185' extending from East Bound of Willow St. Connelly's add. easterly to boundary line of Lot 3, Dec. 6, Plat A, has 3 lots 1 x 2 being 100' wide Lot 3 being 80' wide. Plat A has 7 lots 1 to 7 inclusive, being 100' wide by 280' deep lot 7 being 95' x 280' as shown on map. Dion monuments were placed as shown on map same being 1" x 26"
