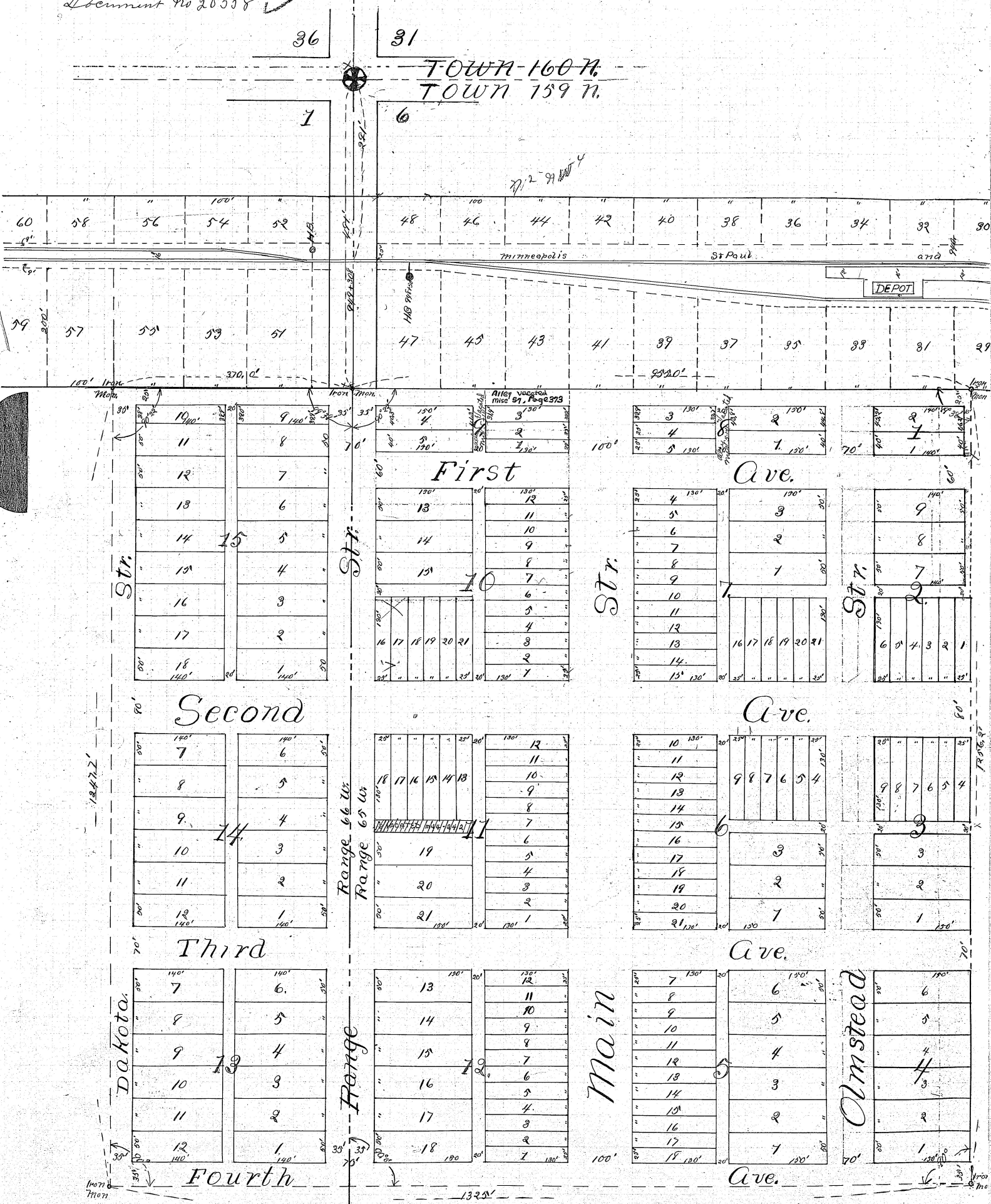


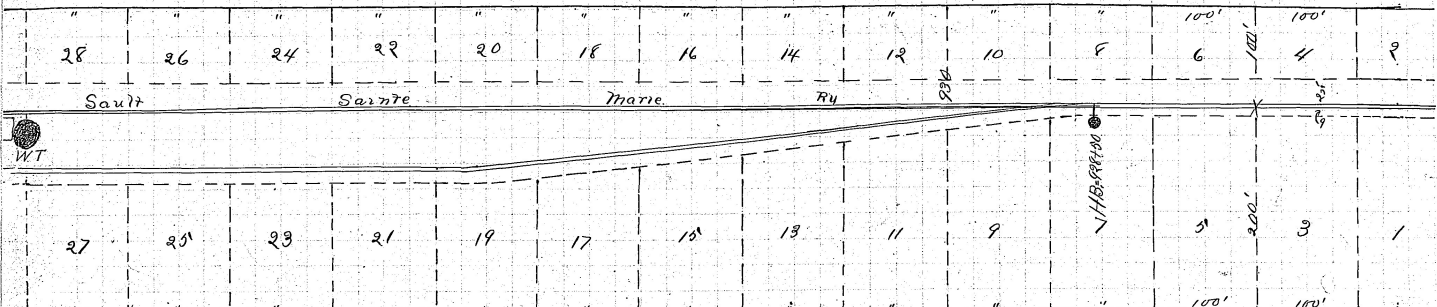

Know all men by these presents, that The Minnesota Loan & Trust Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota, the owner and proprietor of that certain land situated in the County of Towner and State of North Dakota, being all that portion of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section Number Six (6) in Township One Hundred Fifty-Nine (159) North of Range Fifty-Five (55) West and the East Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Number One (1) in Township One Hundred Fifty-Nine (159) North of Range Sixty-Six (66) West described as follows; to-wit:

Beginning at an iron monument on the section line 491.2 feet South from the Northwest corner of Section Six (6) thence East on a line making an angle of 90° 22' to the left 900.0 feet to an iron monument; thence South on a line making an angle of 30° 22' to the right 1206.2 feet to an iron monument; thence West at right angles 1320.0 feet to an iron monument; thence North at right angles 1247.7 feet to an iron monument; thence East on a line making an angle of 89° 38' to the right 370.0 feet to the place of beginning.

Has caused the same to be surveyed, platted and hereafter known as Egeland and hereby donates and dedicates to public use forever all the streets, avenues and alleys thereby shown, In Witness Whereof The Minnesota Loan & Trust Company has caused these presents to be signed by Eugene A.
